- 3. How do the ten plagues in the Book of Exodus demonstrate God's power? What areas of life do they show God as sovereign over?
- 4. In what ways can we be attentive to our spiritual lives? What practices help keep us aware of God's presence and power in our lives?
- 5. In what area of life do you need God's presence and power the most right now? What are you doing to stay aware of God's work in and through you?
