Warm Up:

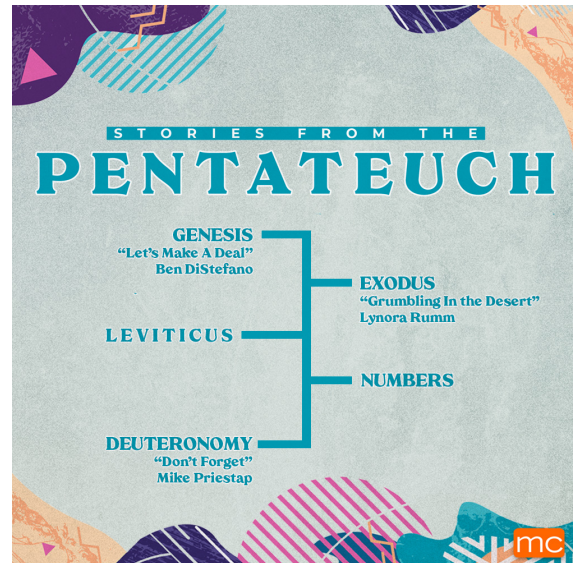
How would you react if God, Yahweh, showed up at your door in human form?
