### Warm up:

### Discuss

1. When you hear the phrase "Zacchaeus really went out on a limb," think about a time when you reached out to someone because you cared about them and how it turned out.
2. Jesus saw Zacchaeus and invited himself to his home. How do you feel when someone invites themselves over to your house? What if Jesus did this to you? Would you be as excited?
3. Describe a time when someone reached out to you and it was perfect timing.
4. Talk about Life Groups in general. What do you like best? What is your best memory of a Life Group? How is your group similar to a family?
