Questions are prepared each week and are designed to prompt insights, questions, and the life experience of each listener. If these are used immediately following the sermon, it would be much the same as what was done in Israel at the time of the early church.

Warm up:

- What does it feel like to lose your keys, your wallet, your purse?
- Did your kids ever wander off at an amusement park or grocery store; what did that feel like?

Read:

Luke 15:1-2; 8-10

Discuss:

- 1. Do you find it interesting that the "sinners" were gathering around Jesus ... what do you think that said about Jesus' character and how he interacted with people?
- 2. Did you ever get the "stink-eye" in church? You know the "look" from someone who thought you were doing something wrong? What does it feel like to be judged in life?
- 3. What kind of energy and effort do you think went into all the widow did to find the coins?
- 4. What does her search suggest about the value of the coins?
- 5. In what ways do we dishonor people?
- 6. In what ways can we show love and affirm dignity to others?
