### Warm up:

Share with the group what you routinely do on a Saturday morning.

### Read and Recap:

The story of David and Bathsheba  
II Samuel 11:1 – 12:14 or  
Immerse: Kingdoms pages 150-152

### Discuss:

- What are some ways in which David could have handled the situation differently? or
- How would you have handled the situation if you were David?
- In what ways do we get off course?



### Read & Discuss:

I Corinthians 10:13

- How has this scripture played out in your life?
- When faced with temptation, do you easily see a way out? Explain your answer.
- When we mess up, is it easy to fess up (confess your wrong doing)? Explain your answer.

### Read & Discuss:

Psalms 51:1-17

- What stands out to you in these verses?
- How does this Psalm change your relationship with God?
- Considering the Lenten season, what steps do you need to take to intentionally nurture your relationship with God?

### Pray:

Spend time in prayer regarding these next steps.
