The Red Card

Read:

Psalm 95

Discuss:

1. What feelings or thoughts did William Barton's story, "The Red Card," evoke in you? What did it make you think about?
2. How does regret keep us from fully living into the present? How is faith an antidote to regret?
3. What causes anxiety when we think about the future? How does the knowledge that God is writing our story help overcome anxiety?
4. What would characterize a day that we lived fully? What would it look like to be fully present in a positive way in the day that was before us?
5. Why does the author of Psalm 95 invite us to begin the day with worship? How does worship enable us to be fully present in the day ahead?
6. What other advice does the author of Psalm 95 have for us about living each day fully? What attitude about each day does this Psalm call forth?
