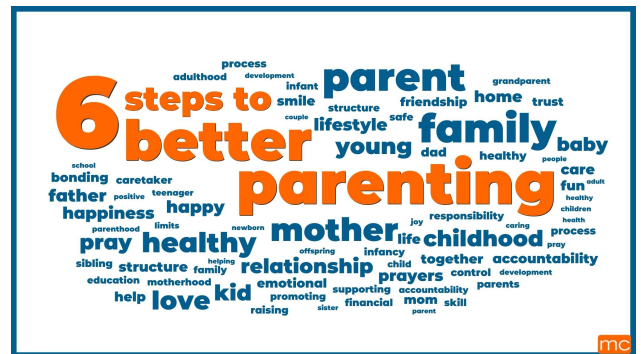


Talk It Over

Questions are prepared each week and are designed to prompt insights, questions, and the life experience of each listener. If these are used immediately following the sermon, it would be much the same as what was done in Israel at the time of the early church.

Discuss:

1. If you are a parent, where or how did you learn your parenting skills? What or who was your most helpful resource in learning to be a parent?
2. Do you agree that our initial parenting skills are learned from the people who parented us? What did you learn about parenting from your parents?
3. If you have multiple children, how did your parenting style change with each? What stayed the same?
4. How would you compare how God relates to you with the way you relate to your children or with the way your parents related to you? What can you learn about parenting from the way God parents you?
5. How do you teach right from wrong while being mindful of the grey? How does God seem to do this?
6. Do you have a practice of regularly praying for your children? What does that practice look like?
