### Discuss

1. For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the greatness of his government and peace there will be no end. **Isaiah 9:6-7**  
In the scripture above, it is said that Jesus is the Prince of Peace. How has Jesus being part of your life helped to give you peace, even in the last year?
2. **Read Mark 5:25-34.**  
In some translations, verse 34 says this: "And he said unto her, Daughter, thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace, and be whole of thy plague." How has a physical challenge caused you to come to Jesus for help? And how has God healed your mind and heart and given you peace in the midst of your pain?
3. Discuss the differences of these two statements (both are true and powerful but are different)
  - Jesus GIVES me peace.
  - Jesus IS my peace.
4. How can coming near to Jesus provide you in this coming week with:
  - Peace with God?
  - Peace with others?
  - Peace with yourself?
