Discuss

1. Do you find it easy to read the Bible? What is your greatest obstacle?
2. Do you have a favorite place to read in the Bible? Why?
3. Is there a verse of the Bible which has been important to you through certain moments in your life?
4. Spend a moment reading Psalm 51 and then talk about it as a group.
5. How could this Psalm become significant in your life right now to restore you to a healthy and strong place with God?
6. In the week ahead take some time with this Psalm every day. Listen to it, read it and even select a verse or two that you might memorize for encouragement. This could be a very clear step to take in making the Bible your own.
