Questions are prepared each week and are designed to prompt insights, questions, and the life experience of each listener. If these are used immediately following the sermon, it would be much the same as what was done in Israel at the time of the early church.

Discuss

Can you share a time in your life when you sensed God whispering something to you: to speak to someone, call someone, explore a new venture?

What did that sound/feel like to you?

What were the circumstances of life — be as specific as possible: day, dates, season of life, location, what was happening in your town, country, etc.?

- 1. Describe the "specifics" you read in this passage.
- 2. Why do you think Luke included some of these details?
- 3. Have you ever thought of the home owner (probably more of a modern-day event venue host), and why he was so willing to immediately say yes?
- 4. What hesitations do we have when we sense God inviting us into something?
- 5. In what ways has God's trustworthiness been a comfort to you?

Rhetorical/Ponder: Is there something that God has been inviting you to, leading you to, that you've been reluctant about? What truths from this passage can be of help to you?
