

## Talk It Over

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*Questions are prepared each week and are designed to prompt insights, questions, and the life experience of each listener. If these are used immediately following the sermon, it would be much the same as what was done in Israel at the time of the early church.*

### Week 4: COMMUNION

#### Discuss:

1. Read Luke 22:14-23. What stands out to you in this account of the Last Supper? What is the setting?
2. If you grew up attending church, how was communion celebrated in the church in which you were raised? What are your early memories of communion?
3. Why do you think Jesus chose a meal as the way by which his followers would remember him? What was the significance of choosing a meal? Why not choose some other symbol or practice?
4. How does your understanding of communion change by knowing that the early church observed this tradition by enjoying a full meal together? What was lost when Communion went from being a full meal to a symbolic observance?
5. How does a meal with other people re-member Christ?
6. How did this weekend's experience of Communion change your understanding of this important tradition?
