- 3. How is the role of women affected by the Fall according to Genesis 3?



- 4. How did this talk challenge or affirm your beliefs about gender roles and leadership within the church and society?
- 5. Have you personally experienced or witnessed gender bias or inequality in religious or secular contexts? How did those experiences shape your views on gender and leadership?
- 6. What can the church do to help restore God's creation ideal for men and women?
