WORK AS WORSHIP

Whether you are in an office, a construction site, working remotely, a stay-at-home parent, caretaker...whatever you do each day, consider a few of these questions alone or with a group:

1. Do you see your "work" as a place where God has called you? Do you think that God placed you there for a reason -- maybe to influence a coworker, to develop a skill for a future calling, or to grow in patience and perseverance?



- 2. How does your attitude reflect Christ? If someone didn't know you were a Christian, would they be able to tell based on your actions?
- 3. Are you working for man's approval or God's glory? Do you work harder when someone is watching? Are you constantly looking for praise, promotions, or validation? If Jesus were there physically beside you, would you work differently?
- 4. Who can you serve and encourage this week? Who is struggling and how can you help them?
- 5. Do you trust God with your future? Are you anxious about the next where you go from here? Do you struggle with comparison? How can you surrender your future plans to God?
