Our Talk It Over is prepared each week by the teaching pastor and is designed to prompt insights, questions and dialogue based on the life experience of each listener. Using these in a group setting after hearing the message is similar to the practices of the early church in Israel.

Warm-Up:

What is one “new era” moment you’ve experienced in life—a time when something old ended and something new began—and how did you feel during that transition?

Read:

Isaiah 6:1-8

Discuss:



1. How do times of change or uncertainty impact your ability to see God’s plan clearly?
2. Why do you think endings are often necessary before we can step into something new?
3. What stands out to you about the way Isaiah responded to God’s call?
4. How does focusing on a specific group of people or region make a mission more effective?
5. In what ways do you personally experience God’s presence through the church community?
6. What “barriers” in your own life make it difficult to fully see or follow Jesus right now?
7. How can you help make Christ more visible in your community this week?
8. What spiritual practices help you stay connected to Jesus when everything feels like it’s shifting?
9. Where do you sense God calling you to serve, and what might keep you from saying, “Here am I, send me”?
10. How might you use your unique gifts or resources to meet the needs of people right where you live?

Closing Prayer

Lord, thank you for guiding us into this new season. Give us eyes to see where you are at work and courage to say, “Here am I—send me.” Help us remove barriers in our own lives and in our community so others can clearly see you. Unite us as a church to follow your mission with faith, hope, and love. Amen.
