



TALK IT OVER

Our Talk It Over is prepared each week by the teaching pastor and is designed to prompt insights, questions and dialogue based on the life experience of each participant. Using these in a group setting after hearing the message is similar to the practices of the early church in Israel.

Warm-Up

- Think about a time when you got lost—while driving, hiking, or just in life. What helped you find your way again?

Discuss

1. Psalm 25 describes God as the one who shows us “the right path.” What does that image of God as a guide mean to you personally?
2. Why do you think we sometimes end up “walking in circles” spiritually, even when we want to follow God’s path?
3. How does having a community of faith—like a small group or church—help us stay on the main trail in life?
4. The psalmist prays, “Lead me by your truth and teach me.” What are some ways God teaches or corrects you when you’ve wandered?
5. What does it look like for you to “own your faith” instead of borrowing it from others?



Apply

This week, take one intentional step toward walking on God’s path, for example:

- Spend ten quiet minutes each day asking God to “show you the right path
- Write down one truth or insight that stands out from your Scripture reading or Sunday message
- Share that truth with someone—a family member, friend, or Life Group member—and talk about how you’ll live it out.

Pray

Lord, You are our guide and our rescuer. Thank you for walking with us, even when we lose our way. Show us the right path and give us the courage to follow it. Teach us through your truth, draw us closer through repentance and reverence, and fill us with the richness of your friendship and grace. Help us walk with others so we never journey alone.
