



# TALK IT OVER

*Our Talk It Over is designed to prompt insights, questions and dialogue based on the life experience of each participant. Using these in a group setting after hearing the message is similar to the practices of the early church in Israel. Choose just one or a few of the questions to consider this week.*

## WARM UP:

Share about a time when you felt unqualified or afraid — yet had to step into something important anyway. What happened?

## DISCUSS:

1. Gideon begins his story afraid and hiding, yet God calls him a “mighty hero.” How does this challenge the way we see ourselves and others?
2. What do Gideon’s repeated requests for confirmation reveal about both human doubt and God’s patience?
3. What is one current battle — external or internal — where you need to hear, “The Lord is with you”?
4. How can you “go with the strength you have” this week instead of waiting until you feel fully ready or confident?



## APPLY:

This week, identify one challenge you’re currently facing.

- Pray specifically about it
- Claim a scripture promise related to God’s presence
- Take **one** step forward in obedience — even if you still feel unsure
- Write down that step and share it with your Life Group or a friend for encouragement and accountability.

## PRAY:

Lord, thank you that you see us through a different lens than our fears do. Thank you that your presence defines who we are, not our weakness or our doubts. Give us the courage to respond like Gideon — to go with the strength we have, trusting that you are with us and You are sending us. Strengthen our hearts, guide our steps, and help us walk in faithful obedience. In Jesus’ name, Amen.
